Thank you for your email. Your queries derive from the edited report that Bentham News made from our full-page update to the Bentham Town Council.

The Bentham News edited report misses some context as a result. It states: "..... Angus Fire have engaged the services of Geosyntec Consultants, an environmental consulting and engineering firm, to address complex problems involving our environment, natural resources and civil infrastructure"
