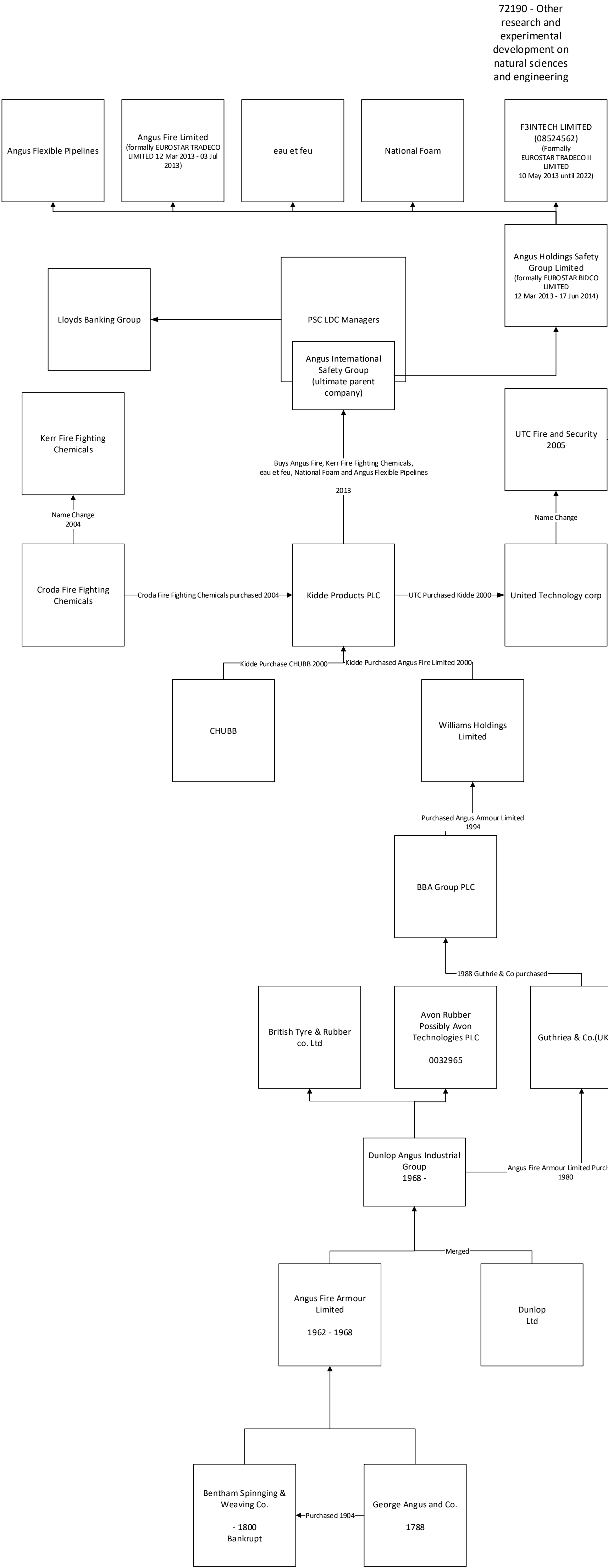

2013 – Angus Fire separates from UTC as a result of a management buyout and forms the Angus International Safety Group

2005 – Kidde plc acquired by United Technologies Corp. and combined with Chubb to form UTC Fire & Security with headquarters in Connecticut, USA

2000 – Williams plc de-merged into Kidde plc and Chubb plc. Angus Fire becomes part of Kidde plc

1994 – Williams Holdings acquire Angus Fire Armour Limited from BBA

1988 – BBA acquired Guthrie

1980 – Guthrie acquires Angus from Dunlop

1977 – Hose factory opened in North Carolina, USA 1962 – Angus Fire Armour Limited formed

1904 – Company purchased the hose and belting part of the Bentham Spinning & Weaving Co. and started to manufacture hose at Bentham

1788 – Company registered as a Public Company under the name of George Angus & Company Limited

Ultimate Parent Company: Angus International Safety Group (Document 20, Point 22).
